What is the Creativity Club? Would you like to join us?

Students will work in teams of 5-7 members with an adult and they will work on solving some creative spontaneous (spur-of-the moment thinking challenges) problems. Two examples of the problems are: building a structure out of spaghetti and tape and discovering how many pennies it will hold, or they may have some clay and they need to make something with their clay and tell a story about their clay creations. Each week they will have some problems to solve and when they solve each problem they will discuss what they did, other ways they could have solved the problem and finally they will discuss what they learned. This is a great opportunity for students to pursue their interest in teamwork, creativity and problem solving. With the students working in small groups, many adult volunteers are needed.
